Jason Sinclair appointed temporary General Manager - PIPE Domestic

PIPE Networks Limited (ASX:PWK) today announced the appointment of Mr Jason Sinclair as General Manager of PIPE Networks' domestic operations. Since February 2008 Mr Sinclair has served as PIPE Networks' Chief Operating Officer and in July 2008 became an executive Director and will continue to serve on PIPE Networks' Board.

This new role will operate until the end of this year and has been implemented to enable Group CEO and Managing Director, Mr Bevan Slattery, to concentrate on the imminent launch of the PPC-1 submarine cable system and the Company's International operations. Mr Slattery will continue to serve as CEO of the combined entity.

Mr Slattery said "Since coming on board Jason has been an integral part of PIPE Networks and I am delighted that he has accepted this role. The domestic business has been operating strongly and has a proven and talented management team. Jason's focus on domestic operations will provide me an excellent opportunity to maximise the prospects presented by the imminent launch of PPC-1 and our international business. This is an exciting period of growth for the Company."

The PPC-1 submarine cable system consists of 6,900 km of submarine cable from Sydney to Guam and once completed will be Australia's first independent, carrier neutral cable. PPC-1 is scheduled for completion in September this year.

Mr Sinclair's appointment takes effect from today. It is expected that upon completion of the PPC-1 system a review of the overall operational structure of the Company will be conducted.
