Supreme Court of Queensland Approves TPG Telecom Limited's Acquisition of PIPE Networks Limited

TPG Telecom Limited (ASX: TPM) (TPG Telecom) and PIPE Networks Limited (ASX: PWK) (PIPE Networks) today announce that the Supreme Court of Queensland has issued orders approving the Scheme of Arrangement between PIPE Networks and its shareholders (other than TPG Telecom) (the Scheme) involving TPG Telecom acquiring all of the shares in PIPE Networks which it does not already own for \$6.30 cash per share (the Scheme Consideration). The Court orders follow the overwhelming support of PIPE Networks shareholders who voted in favour of the Scheme at the Scheme Meeting held on 12 March 2010.

The Court orders have been lodged with the ASIC and the Scheme is therefore Effective as of today. The orders will now be lodged with the ASX and trading in PIPE Networks shares on the ASX will be suspended from close of trading today.

The Scheme is scheduled to be Implemented on Wednesday, 31 March 2010, with the Scheme Consideration to be despatched to PIPE Networks shareholders on Wednesday, 7 April 2010. The entitlements to the Scheme Consideration under the Scheme will be determined at 5.00 pm on Wednesday, 24 March 2010.
